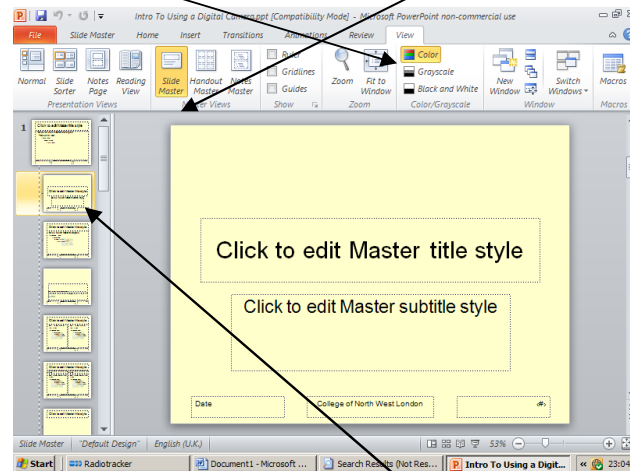


How to apply Animations to all slides in a presentation in PowerPoint 2010

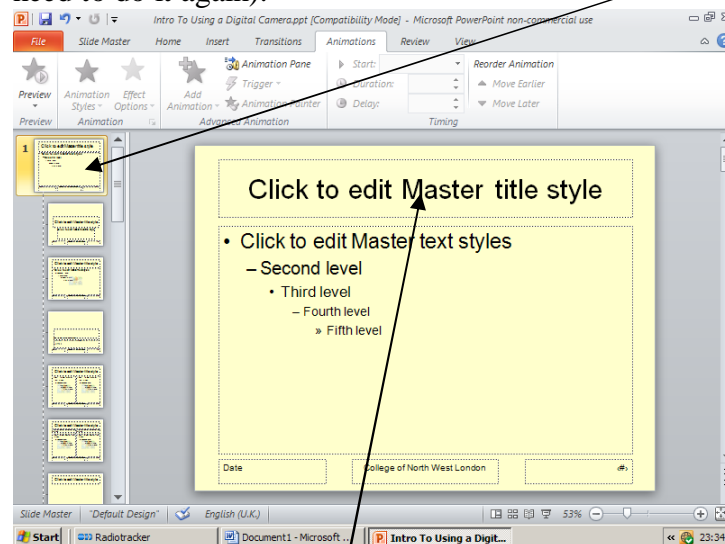
Open a presentation with several slides such as your Hobbies exercise.

Click on View and then Slide Master.

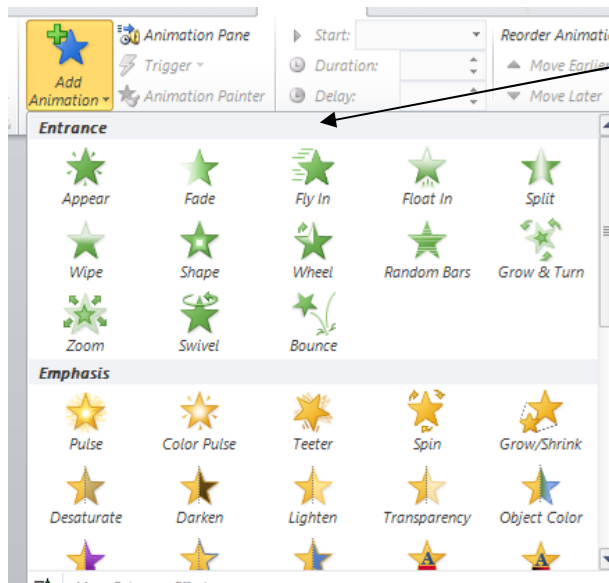


“A slide master is the top slide in a hierarchy of slides that stores information about the theme and slide layouts of a presentation, including the background, colour, fonts, effects, placeholder sizes, and positioning.” (PowerPoint help) In other words you can set formatting that will apply to all slides.

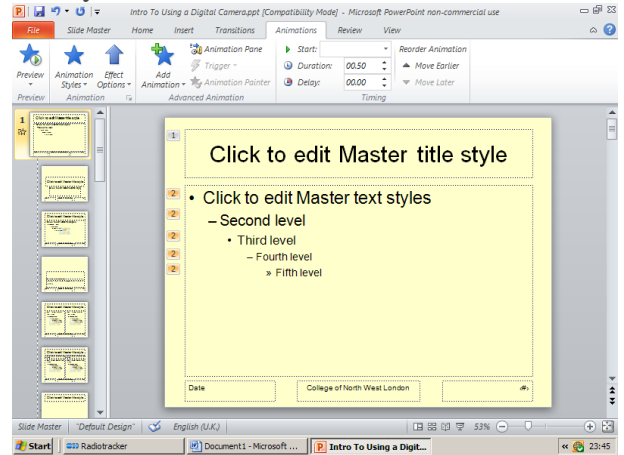
Click on Animations and change from the second slide to the first slide (if you do this in View it will revert to the second slide when you change to Animations so you will need to do it again).



Then click on **Click to edit Master title style** and click on Add Animation



Then click on Fly In. Repeat this for **Click to edit Master subtitle style**. The sub points will appear to fly in together in the preview, but they actually will appear separately and one by one.



When you have applied the animations it will look similar to the picture above right, with numbers against the points. Note these will only be visible in Master Slide view with the Animations tab selected (not just Master Slide View).

Click on View and Normal.

Then go to Slide show and View show from the beginning to check that it is working.
