## **HARROW U3A MEMBERSHIP**

The U3A (University of the Third Age) is open to all men and women who have ceased full-time employment. The sole criteria is a desire to learn for its own sake, whether academic subjects, physical activities or taking a tour.

Annual membership for a single person is £30 and £55 for a couple who live at the same address. For people who receive Income Support or Pension Credit the annual fee is £5.

Your subscription covers you for attendance at any class and monthly meetings at which there is a guest speaker. There is nothing more to pay unless your group leader produces handouts and asks for a contribution towards the cost.

You will receive a Newsletter produced three times a year and which gives reports on past activities and news about forthcoming ones. There is also a schedule which gives details of all the Study and Interest Groups which are run by Harrow U3A plus short overseas trips, and day and half-day tours to places of interest.

You will also receive U3A News direct from the National Office which gives information on what is going on in the world of adult learning, other U3As around the country and shared learning projects.
